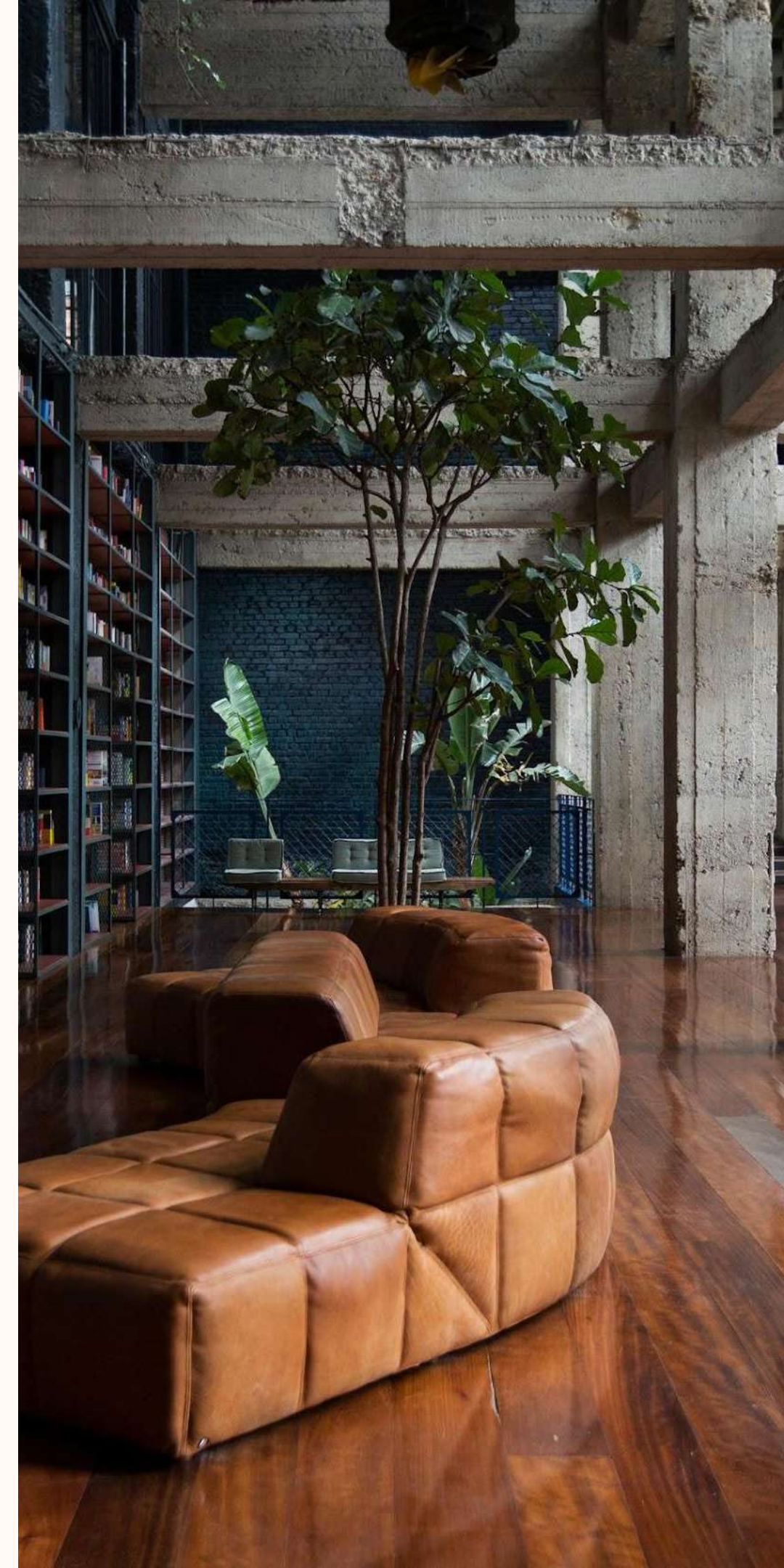

This wine boutique is also known for its branch in Berlin, Germany and its ability to deliver Georgian wines worldwide on favorable terms.



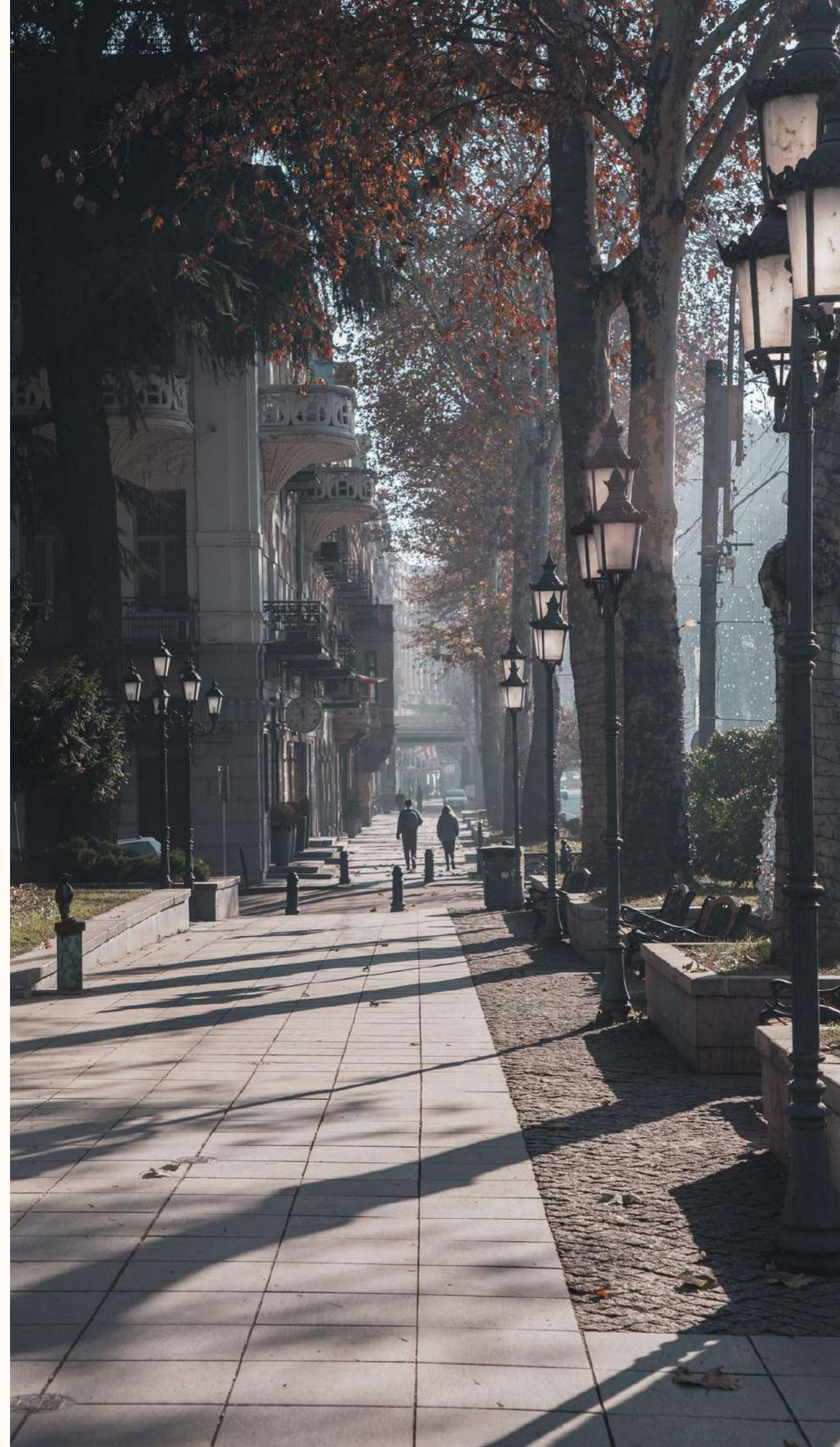
TOURISM ACTIVITY

Old Tbilisi
