6D5N - Georgia Day 1 - Destination





Tbilisi

One of the oldest European capitals, Tbilisi has been the cultural, political and economic center of Georgia (the country) for fifteen centuries. At the heart of the city is the historic Old Tbilisi, built during the early Middle Ages. This two square kilometer area of the city is a must visit for any visitor to Tbilisi, as it is home to some of the city's most iconic landmarks.

Wandering through the old streets, you will see the style known as Tbilisi Art Nouveau, recognizable by the buildings decorated facades and painted lobbies, each ready to tell its own emotional story. Here you will find Bronze Age palaces, medieval temples, fortresses, stained glass Italian courtyards, architectural designs and museums from different eras.







Mtskheta

Mtskheta amazes with unique monuments of Georgian Orthodox architecture, some of which in 1994 were included in UNESCO World Heritage List under the name "Historical Monuments of Mtskheta". Big Mtskheta Archaeological Museum-Reserve integrates the city of Mtskheta, Samtavro mausoleum and burial ground (II millennium BC - early Middle Ages), Samtavro settlement (VIII-VII centuries BC), Armaztsikhe-Baginetithe residence of the rulers of the Kingdom of Kartli (1st century BC - 8th century AD) and the acropolis.

Mtskheta is set on a lowland, surrounded by mountains, at the confluence of the two rivers, Kura and Aragvi. The city is approached from the north by the Greater Caucasus and from the south by the Lesser Caucasus mountains.

Kakheti

Kakheti is a historical and geographical region in Eastern Georgia and one of the largest regions of the country.

Kakheti is famous for its abundance of cultural monuments. Numerous churches, monasteries and castles attract the attention of tourists and sightseers. The most famous cultural monuments of Kakheti are: Ninotsminda, Bodbe, Hornabuji, Ujarma, Signagi, Gurjaani All Saints, Alaverdi, New and Old Shuamta, Ikalto, Gremi, Nekresi.

Kakheti is a special region of Georgia, which is adored by tourists. It has the most vineyards and wine production than the rest of the country. There are up to 200 wine varieties in the area. The most popular varieties are Rkatsiteli, Kahuri Mtsvane, Khikhvi, Kisi and Saperavi.



6D5N - Georgia Day 5 - Kazbegi





Kazbegi

Kazbek is perhaps the most famous of all the mountains in Georgia. It rises to 5047 meters. Here, at the foot of Kazbek or Mkinvartsveri - a mountain with glacial peaks - stands the Church of the Holy Trinity Gergetis Tsminda Sameba - one of the most picturesque temples in Georgia. It is not difficult to climb up here, and at the end of the way you will get excellent views of Kazbek, rocky ridge, valley and the whole village of Kazbegi (Stepantsminda). It is in Stepantsminda that one of the best hotels in Georgia is located - Rooms Hotel Kazbegi.

The surroundings of Stepantsminda are very picturesque: the Terek River flows under the town, and snow-capped peaks of the Caucasus rise above it, valley glaciers and forests, both deciduous and coniferous, are scattered everywhere.
